School volunteering overview I

Volunteer opportunities

- Room parent
 - Head room parent vs. room parent
 - Organize class parties and events, teacher appreciation week, ad hoc help
 - Sign up in summer
- Library
 - Weekly or bi-weekly help, check-in and check-out books, see your children in class
- Green team
 - Sign up at your convenience
 - See your children at lunch
 - Save the environment





School volunteering overview II

Volunteer opportunities (-continued)

- Big backyard walk
 - Training right before the walk
 - Focus on nature
 - Hang out with your children
- Field trips
 - Parent chaperones
- Can double income family get involved? Yes!
- CORI required





Site Council

- Required by the state
- Harrington as example, format might be slightly different for each school:
- The School Site Council for the Harrington School is a group of parents, teachers, and a community member.
- Assist the Principal in identifying the educational needs of the school, and in formulating an annual School Improvement Plan.
- Parent representatives to the School Council are elected each spring, and serve for a term of two years beginning the following Fall. Teacher representatives are elected by the faculty, and also serve for a two-year term.

○ PTA vs. PTO

- ✓ PTA: Parent Teacher Association, pay dues to state/national organizations
- ✓ PTO: Parent teacher Organization, independent, no dues

○ How to join PTA

- ✓ Instructions usually are included in school welcome package, or join via PTA website
- ✓ Harrington basic membership \$27, gold membership \$100
- ✓ PTA Average spend on each student \$90
- ✓ Sponsor many other community events
- ✓ Access to student directory


PTA financials: Income
